

## 2024 World AIDS Day Grant Program

### **Grant Application Information**

World AIDS Day (WAD) is commemorated annually on 1 December. WAD holds significant global importance in raising awareness about HIV and AIDS, showing support for people living with HIV, remembering those who have died from AIDS related illness, and uniting efforts to end HIV stigma. The theme for WAD this year is "It Starts with Me," which emphasises personal responsibility and the role each individual plays in the fight against HIV and AIDS and ultimately working towards ending the transmission.

WAAC is facilitating small grants to assist the delivery of projects and/or events that align with the WAD theme. The grant program provides financial assistance of up to \$1,000 to remote or regional organisations, to support the WA community to address sexual health and blood-borne virus issues through community engagement and collaborative partnerships. Health Promotion Officers, Public and Community Health Nurses, Aboriginal Health Workers and other relevant personnel in regional and remote WA are encouraged to apply.

#### **Considerations**

- Grants <u>cannot</u> be used for internal salaries, wages, internal professional development or regular ongoing service delivery.
- Grants <u>can</u> be used for participation incentives, prizes, venue hire and guest speakers, or outsourced contractors relevant to the project. Catering can be covered by the grant as part of a broader community engagement strategy.
- If you choose to target a priority population, it is recommended that you include a community representative in the planning and implementation of your project.
- Partnerships with other organisations are encouraged; however, the project must be coordinated by the applicant.

#### **Eligibility Criteria**

The following criteria must be met:

- Your organisation is based in regional or remote WA.
- The project must directly benefit the WA community or priority population.

### **Instructions for Applying**

Applications are due at 5pm on **14 October 2024 via <u>kreeves@waac.com.au</u>**. Please allow 48 hours for confirmation of receipt of your application.











### **Grant Approval Process**

In partnership with the WA Health, Sexual Health and Blood-borne Virus Program, each application will be considered against the following criteria:

- Evidence demonstrating the applicant and project meets the eligibility criteria.
- Evidence demonstrating the project aligns with the World AIDS Day theme.
- Evidence demonstrating the project benefits the community and priority population.
- The overall appeal and suitability of the proposed project.

Successful applicants will be notified by 25 October 2024.

#### Requirements if successful

- Your organisation must use resources (i.e., safe sex packs) provided by WAAC.
- Your organisation must attend a 1-hour online HIV and AIDS training in October in preparation for your project.
- The project must coincide or launch on WAD and be completed by Sunday, 8 December.
- A 300-word summary must be provided to WAAC to be published on the WAAC website no later than Friday, 20 December 2024. Please see example.
