About Freedom

Freedom provides a range of services supporting LGBTIQA+ young people aged 12-25 years across metro and regional WA.

Our services include Freedom Centre (FC), Youth Counselling, and Community Development.

FC is a peer-led drop-in centre for LGBTIQA+ young people, where we provide peer support informed by lived experience.

We host drop-in sessions that are safe spaces to:

- Meet other LGBTIQA+ young people
- Access support from our peer educators
- Access referrals to counselling and other services
- Find information related to your community
- Hang out and have fun

Our drop-in sessions are free, and we have guidelines and responsibilities to ensure everyone who visits is safe and respected.

Our Sessions

Our sessions run from **4-7:30pm in person**, or from **4-8pm online** for specific age groups. Check out our website or social media to find our monthly schedule.

Drop-in

A drop-in space for LGBTIQA+ young people with **Under 18s** for ages 12-17 and **Over 18s** for ages 18-25 sessions available.

Gender Q

A space specifically reserved for **people aged 17-25** who identify within the trans or gender diverse community or are questioning their gender identity.

Online

Our online drop-in runs through Discord, an online space to chat and connect, with alternating Over 18 and Under 18* sessions.

*Under 18 session on Discord are for ages 13-17

Community Development

Freedom provides community capacity building initiatives including inclusion training, workforce development, community events, and activities through our Community Development program.

Community development is offered in-person in the **Perth Metro** area, as well as **Geraldton, Kalgoorlie,** and the **South West.**

Alternative forms of support are offered outside of in-person areas.
