HIV testing

We know that sometimes the thought of getting tested can be daunting, that's why we provide HIV testing in a casual and relaxed environment so no matter the outcome, we'll be here to support you through it.

If you're not comfortable being tested by us at the clinic, we can offer you **Atomo HIV self-testing kits** to use at home, which can give you results after 15 minutes. You can order these online at **hivtest.au**.

Did you know?

M Clinic is largely funded by the WA
Department of Health. Because of this, we can
provide **low cost** STI testing for our clients.

If you are experiencing financial difficulty, we can even provide your testing **for free!**

PrEP prescriptions

PrEP (pre-exposure prophylaxis) is a medicine that requires a prescription which reduces your risk of contracting HIV from others, and helps reduce the spread of HIV in the community.

PrEP reduces the risk of getting HIV by *up to* 99% if taken correctly, and may help reduce any anxiety you may feel around contracting HIV.

Vaccinations

As part of our service, we offer a range of sexual health related vaccinations for our clients who are not already immune, including for:

- Hepatitis A and B
- HPV, and
- Mpox

It is necessary to book an appointment ahead of time for all vaccinations that we provide.

How often to test?

You should have an STI test every **3** months if you have sex with multiple partners, **1 year** if you are in a monogamous relationship, or **even sooner** if you notice any symptoms.

Gender affirming care

We are proud to offer gender affirming care for our trans, gender diverse and non-binary clients who are 18 and over seeking hormone replacement therapy.

Booking in for our gender clinic requires a referral from a GP. For all more details, please visit our *gender affirming care* webpage.
